

## (LEADS TO ETERNAL LIFE)

(Ref 2 Cor.7:10) "For godly sorrow produces repentance <u>leading to</u> salvation, a repentance not to be regretted;"

<u>Repentance</u> means to confess a former attitude (or a course of action), and to <u>change</u> to another. All the natural <u>ways</u> of humans are really the <u>ways</u> of Satan. So, in the <u>divine life</u>, repentance means to turn <u>from</u> the old ways of Satan, to accept God's pathway to <u>Life</u>, with a cleansed <u>heart</u>, a humble perspective and full surrender of the <u>'self-life'...(which God must take from</u> our hearts to prepare us for Eternal <u>Life</u>). Nothing else could be <u>more valuable</u> than to get rid of 'self' from our heart, and to <u>start over</u> on <u>God's</u> pathway with a clean and humble <u>heart</u>, (the result of a <u>genuine repentance</u> in God's sight), because it is the only pathway leading to eternal Life.

Repentance means to be willing to give up every unscriptural attitude in our lives, and to learn under the teaching of God to become Scriptural in everything,-(which will be directly opposite to what we were by nature). True repentance and a new commitment to do God's 'will' in our life, brings spiritual development of greater results than anything else we could do. It enables one to receive full pardon and cleansing from sin that Jesus Christ purchased for us, (which is the first valuable result because it lays the foundation for a truly successful Christian 'life of faith'). Very few professing Christians have that foundation because they did not start right with a true repentance. The most important result is repentance allows us to be filled with the Holy Spirit who will prepare us for Eternal Life

Anyone who has <u>never</u> <u>truly repented</u> and <u>received</u> <u>the</u> <u>Holy</u> <u>Spirit</u>, would <u>never</u> <u>think</u> for a moment that <u>Satan</u> was the <u>ruler</u> of their life, and that they were <u>living in his will</u>. However, a <u>true</u> <u>repentance</u> (in its broadest sense), <u>means</u> that <u>God</u> takes <u>possession</u> of <u>us</u>, <u>becomes</u> our personal <u>teacher</u>, and <u>He will guide</u> <u>us</u> <u>out</u> <u>of</u> every <u>unscriptural</u> <u>thing</u> in our life, while teaching and training us to <u>become fully</u> <u>Scriptural</u> in every part of our life. We need to be <u>led</u> <u>away</u> from every <u>human</u> <u>way</u> and human <u>thing</u> we are trusting in, and, be taught by the Holy Spirit to fully trust God alone for all things.

Satan <u>controls people</u> in a way just <u>opposite</u> to that, however, by the thoughts that <u>he</u> puts in their mind, which seem exactly like their own thoughts, and that is why it is so <u>easy</u> for him to <u>control</u> people. One of <u>Satan's</u> favorite <u>plans</u> is to <u>get people</u> to <u>accept</u> a <u>false</u> <u>religion</u>, of which <u>there are</u> large numbers in the world, and <u>all</u> are 'claiming' to be of God and according to His will.

(The late Pastor noted) that the Christian Science religion is a delusion from Satan which rejects the 'Blood of Christ' and His atonement work on the Cross for us. It rejects the supreme Deity of a personal Father, a Son of the Father, and a Holy Spirit. To believe

<u>such</u> a <u>false</u> <u>teaching</u> would <u>instantly</u> <u>destroy</u> all <u>faith</u>, <u>hope</u>, and <u>love</u>, because all of these blessings have their <u>foundation</u> <u>in</u> a personal God (a <u>Christ</u>, <u>and</u> a <u>Holy</u> <u>Spirit</u>).

<u>Could anything be more wicked than to attempt to destroy</u> mankind's <u>only hope</u> of <u>receiving God's favor</u> and <u>blessings</u> for eternity (by rejecting the <u>Blood of Christ</u>)? Only a person being <u>used</u> <u>as an instrument of Satan</u>, could teach such a dreadful <u>false doctrine</u>. (Rom. 5:8-10 clearly <u>states</u>), "But God gives proof of His love to us in Christ's dying for us while we were still sinners. If therefore we have now been pronounced free from guilt <u>through His</u> <u>blood</u>, much more shall we be <u>delivered</u> from <u>God's anger</u> through Him. For if <u>while</u> we were <u>hostile</u> to God, we were <u>reconciled</u> to Him <u>through</u> the <u>death</u> of His Son, it is still <u>more certain</u> that now that we are reconciled, we shall obtain 'salvation' through Christ's life."

Jehovah's Witnesses religion is <u>also</u> a <u>delusion</u> from <u>Satan</u>, and whose <u>false doctrine</u> is, that <u>people</u> who <u>die</u> in their <u>sins</u>, can <u>come</u> <u>back</u> to this world and have another chance to <u>be</u> saved. They say there is <u>no</u> Lake of Fire, and that Hell is only the grave. That is <u>not</u> found in <u>the Bible</u>, as the New Testament <u>tells</u> us <u>plainly</u> there is a <u>Lake</u> of <u>Fire</u> (prepared for the devil and his angels), and no <u>twisting</u> of words could make it mean the grave.

The Seventh Day Adventist religion is another delusion from Satan, whose teaching rejects the millennial reign of Christ, eternal torment, and the Lake of Fire for those who die in sin (unrepentant). They do not trust God for divine healing, rather, they depend on the kind of food they eat (grains, vegetables, etc.) The object of Satan in that delusion is the same as he deceived the Scribes and Pharisees, to be so concerned about observing the Sabbath and placing stress on mere outward observances (but having no real faith in God's divine power). There is not one thing in their teaching, which would lead them back to trusting God, to deal personally with Him in a 'life of faith', get rid of 'self' from their heart, or receive any benefits of Christ's atonement (for this life and eternity). [The worst thing about all these false religions is, their followers never get back to dealing personally with God for things they need to have in this life, (as sincere Christians did in Bible times). ]

We hardly need mention other religious groups, such as Modern Tongues, Spiritualism, and the multitude of Once Saved, Always Saved people. Anyone with true <u>spiritual</u> <u>insight</u> or <u>understanding</u>, would easily see the cloven foot of Satan's influence, and his full control in all those organizations (and that their <u>members</u> <u>stand</u> <u>in need</u> <u>of</u> <u>true</u> 'repentance'). The object of <u>Satan</u> in all of his plans, <u>is</u> to have people to die in their sins, <u>unrepentant</u>, and <u>unprepared</u> <u>for</u> Heaven (so they will spend eternity in the Lake of Fire with him).

God's Word to us in 2<sup>nd</sup>. letter of John, <u>warns us</u> that <u>we are not</u> to accept anybody into our home with a false teaching, and neither should we bid them God-speed when they leave. If we do, we are <u>partakers</u> in their evil deeds. We are to have <u>no</u> Christian fellowship with <u>anyone</u> in any <u>delusion</u>. (2 John 1:9-10) "<u>Whoever</u> transgresses (wanders from the teaching of Christ), and does not abide in the

<u>'doctrine</u> of <u>Christ'</u> ("trusting on the One whom God has sent"),...does <u>not have God</u>. He who <u>abides in</u> the <u>doctrine</u> of <u>Christ</u> has <u>both</u> the <u>Father</u> and <u>the Son</u>. If <u>anyone</u> comes to you and does <u>not</u> bring <u>this</u> <u>doctrine</u>, do <u>not receive</u> him into your house nor <u>greet</u> him" (wish him farewell);... "for he who greets him, shares in his evil deeds."

<u>Any religion that does not teach faith and trust on God's</u> '<u>promises'</u> (relying on the power of Christ's Atonement Blood to bring these results), . <u>is a false religion</u>. It will <u>rob</u> its followers of their great <u>inheritance</u> through <u>Christ</u>, <u>of</u> perfect happiness in this life,...and every <u>hope</u> of Eternal Life in the next. Their members <u>stand in need of true</u> '<u>repentance</u>,' so we should pray for them to give God the opportunity to deal with them in His mercy.

Because professed Christians (and many others) have rejected God's great Salvation Plan, they have been sent strong delusions. (2 Thess. 2: 10-12), "So Satan works, and by every kind of wicked deception for those who are on the way to perdition, because they did not welcome into their hearts the love of the truth, so that they might be saved. And for this reason, God sends them a misleading influence (a strong delusion), that they may believe the lie; in order that all may "come under judgement" who have refused to believe the truth and have taken pleasure in unrighteousness."

However, the <u>Christian life begins with a true repentance</u>, and <u>God will grant that repentance</u> to everyone who is <u>willing</u> to <u>turn back</u> to <u>Him</u> and <u>His Word</u>, and to doing His <u>will</u> by trusting on the One whom He has sent. <u>When we are willing</u> to <u>surrender</u> to <u>do His</u> will, the Holy Spirit is <u>always</u> present to <u>convict</u> us of any <u>unscriptural</u> thing in our life, to give us a true <u>spirit</u> of <u>repentance</u>, and a <u>believing</u>, repentant contrite heart to receive from Him.

In the 13<sup>th</sup>. chapter of Luke, Jesus told us "<u>Why terrible things</u> <u>happened to</u> the Galileans" whose blood Pilate had mingled with their sacrifices. It was <u>not because</u> they were worst sinners in Jerusalem, but <u>simply because</u> they <u>had not 'repented'</u>. He also said, "<u>except ye</u> <u>repent</u>, <u>ye shall all likewise perish</u>".

An evidence of Satan's control over unrepentant people, is that they shut God out of their life, by trying in their own efforts to obtain what they want. Satan's favorite plan is to have them do so under the covering of religion. This can easily be seen by the vast number of people and religions, who totally neglect trusting God for things and circumstances in their life, and who depend wholly on their own plans and efforts.

The <u>facts</u> are, however, that <u>God</u> is still the <u>same</u> <u>Deliverer</u> <u>as</u> <u>He</u> <u>was</u> in Bible times, <u>and</u> Jesus <u>came</u> <u>to</u> <u>deliver</u> <u>us</u> <u>out</u> <u>of</u> all sins, sorrows, diseases, and poverty in this life, <u>and</u>, to give us every need and Scriptural desire to make us happy in Him. Even <u>more</u> <u>importantly</u>, <u>receiving</u> these provisions <u>according</u> <u>to</u> God's <u>Word</u> and <u>by</u> His power, is the only possible way for us to grow <u>spiritually</u> and to <u>be</u> <u>prepared</u> for Eternal Life.

There could be no greater sin <u>than that being committed</u> by a majority of <u>professing Christians</u>, who <u>profess</u> to <u>belong</u> to <u>God</u>, and yet they are doing Satan's will, by trusting in human efforts in

everything. They totally ignore God, and they have no personal dealings with Him, about anything. Trusting in everybody and everything but God is real sin, that is deep-rooted and inspired and controlled by Satan. [To those, Jesus will say, 'begone from Me, I never knew you, you doers of wickedness." (Matt.7;23). For us to belong to any of those church organizations, to support them, listen to their teaching, or, to have any fellowship with them. . would make us a partaker in their evil deeds (under an outward cloak of religion).

There is nothing on earth that could be worse or more 'dangerous' spiritually speaking (and Satan knows that). He will hide behind any outward actions of the self-life that he can devise (under a covering of religion, or otherwise), and to make a person feel more righteous of themselves before God. Satan uses that to deceive a person, instead of them receiving real spiritual light from the Holy Spirit.

When we would allow the devil to deceive us by listening to various opinions of God's Truth, instead of, turning to God's Word and depending on the Holy Spirit to teach and lead us to trust on God, .we would be placing ourselves on the devil's territory to be deceived.

<u>Trusting on God's promises is 'believing'</u> "on the One whom He has sent" (John 6:29) (which is the one requirement that God puts on His plan for our <u>Salvation</u>). (John 12:44-46) 'Jesus <u>cried aloud'</u>, "He who <u>believes</u> in me, believes not so much in me, as in Him who sent me; and he who sees me sees Him who sent me. I <u>have come like Light into the</u> world, in order that no one who believes in me may remain in the <u>dark</u>." (That means, if a person is trusting on God for things in their life, they will receive spiritual Light).

There are valuable examples in the Bible which show the results of real repentance. Repentance is not real unless the decision is final to turn from evil and unscriptural things in our life and make our sincere decision to accept God's Word and do His will. Every bad thing that has ever happened to anyone was caused by an unscriptural attitude toward God and His Word. But, when anyone in any trouble was willing to confess and 'forsake' (their wrong actions or attitudes, and to accept God's will),... they were delivered out of their troubles.

Very few people (if any), have ever been in the kind of trouble that Job was in. Job had a false outward religion of self-effort and self-righteousness. He had never repented right nor had a real change of heart, so, he never received God's righteousness (as Abraham had).

God never said that Job was a <u>spiritual man</u>; He <u>meant</u> that Job <u>was</u> honest, sincere, and whole-hearted <u>in his desire</u> to <u>serve and</u> please God... <u>That</u> does <u>not</u> make a person <u>spiritual</u>, (but that allowed God to work for Job in his heart.)

Many people have the <u>same</u> <u>sincere</u> <u>attitude</u> as Job did, <u>with</u> the same <u>old</u> <u>evil</u> <u>nature</u> still in them, and all that they do, they do in their own <u>outward</u> <u>efforts</u> of the self-life <u>still</u> <u>within</u> their <u>heart</u>, (just as the Scribes and Pharisees).

Acts chapter 10 tells the story of Cornelius (a counterpart of Job), who feared God, prayed to God always, and gave alms to people. Honesty, sincerity, and doing our best from a human standpoint apart from the power of God, is not true spirituality, however. Job and Cornelius were on their way to the Lake of Fire if they had not repented. The difference between them was, that Job was stubborn and determined to hold on to his own ways of doing things (and unwilling to repent). Cornelius was open-minded and willing to change from his ways, to accept God's. Therefore, God told Cornelius that if He would send for the Apostle Peter, he would hear words by which he and his household could be saved (if they would use their power of choice to accept God's Word).

God had a <u>much more difficult time</u> to <u>convince</u> Job to <u>repent</u>. Terrible things <u>had to happen</u> to <u>him</u>. The loss of his children, property and friends, and the loss of his health. He had to <u>come</u> to <u>the end</u> of <u>everything he had</u> (or <u>was depending on</u>), and to sit on an ash-heap with sores all over his body.

Job convinced his three friends that he was all right, and that God was wrong. Then Elihu was inspired to speak to Job, and to prepare the way for God to deal with him. (Job 36:7-12) "He does not take his eyes off the righteous; he enthrones them with kings and exalts them forever. But, if men are bound in chains, held fast by cords of affliction, he tells them what they have done--that they have sinned arrogantly. He makes them listen to correction, and commands them to repent of their evil. If they (the righteous) obey and serve him, they will spend the rest of their days in prosperity and their years in contentment. But if they do not listen, (that's our free-will choice to listen, or not listen, and), "they will perish by the sword and die without knowledge." (meaning, a true knowledge of God).

Job remained silent as he <u>couldn't argue with God's Word through</u> <u>Elihu. Then God dealt with Job personally</u> (as He will do for anyone of us), and <u>He</u> quickly <u>convinced</u> Job <u>that he had</u> a <u>'false religion'</u> (and <u>was depending on his own righteousness as being merit in God's sight),... which meant he had been deceived and robbed by Satan, of being open-minded and willing to receive true religion from God...(all because of Job's <u>own stubbornness</u>). Job was then willing to <u>confess</u> and <u>forsake his way</u>(which he did, Job 42:6), "Therefore I despise myself and repent in dust and ashes." <u>Then God could turn his</u> <u>captivity around and deliver him from the bondage of a Satan-inspired</u> <u>false religion of self-righteousness</u>.</u>

A vast majority of <u>professing</u> <u>Christians</u> would see Job's trouble as he himself did (when he was filled with self and Satan). They <u>have</u> a <u>false</u> <u>understanding</u>, that there is <u>no</u> <u>spiritual</u> <u>cause'</u> for <u>trouble</u> in this life.

However, <u>false religion is the cause</u> of all the trouble there is in the world, and <u>all wars in the world are the result of false</u> <u>religions</u>, (Roman Catholic, many Protestants, and a host <u>of other</u> <u>religions</u> in the countries that were conquered). Not one of them know anything about <u>living according to God's Word or trusting in Him alone</u> for <u>anything</u> in life. They are all just the <u>opposite</u> of the <u>Bible</u> <u>standard</u> of Christian living, and they are doing it all under a <u>covering of religion</u>, which makes it the most wicked, demoniacal, and <u>worst form of hypocrisy</u> that there could possibly be (<u>because</u> it <u>leads</u> multitudes to the 'Lake of Fire'). False religions reject the work of <u>Atonement by</u> Jesus Christ, and all that it accomplished and provided <u>for anyone to 'believe'</u> and <u>accept as their 'inheritance in Christ'</u>. <u>True 'repentance'</u> (followed by <u>our commitment</u> to <u>trust on the</u> <u>power of the Atonement Blood of Christ</u>), will also mean that we are to be delivered from every evil thing; (sin, sorrow, sickness, poverty, family trouble, and everything else that disturbs our peace, (because Jesus' Blood covers everything in a true Christian life). We are to be protected from every evil thing or person, and disease or accident.

We are to have the same blessings and deliverance, the same spiritual guidance, the same health and protection of our body, the same answers to prayer and manifestations of God's presence, mercy, and power in everything, (as true <u>believers</u> in Bible times had). (Summary) True repentance and a new commitment to do God's Will in our life, will bring great spiritual results along with cleansing and pardon from sin, lead us into our true inheritance in Christ, and most importantly, have us <u>prepared to receive Eternal Life</u>!

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S236R/ MAIN POINTS:

The Christian life must begin with a 'right start', that is, a 1. sincere repentance and final surrender of our 'self-will'. It is to confess and forsake all wrong actions and decisions in our life. Satan's object is for people to die in sin, unrepentant, and 2. unprepared for Heaven, and he uses false religions to deceive people to think that they are spiritually righteous of themselves Any religion that does not teach faith and trust on God's 3. promises is a 'false religion'. Most all 'false religions' reject the power in the Atonement sacrifice of Jesus Christ, and they do not teach anyone to get back to dealing personally with God, ... Who will convict and bring every 'willing soul' to repent. Nothing could be more wicked than to destroy mankind's only hope 4. of receiving God's favor, because of one rejecting the Blood of Christ.

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
