For a person to truly understand the 'Salvation Message' that Jesus Christ brought for everyone on this earth, (and what the 'covering Blood' of His 'atonement sacrifice' really accomplished for us),... is, the most important thing that any Christian could ever come to know during their lifetime on earth. The work of atonement that Jesus Christ made in our behalf can be separated into parts, (as to why He had to make that sacrifice, what He accomplished for us by doing so, and the benefits of one believing on the power of His atonement Blood sacrifice). We want to fully comprehend why Jesus came to this earth, and why He had to take our place on the cross. He came to shed His blood, to cleanse us of sin in our life, and to redeem our life from the 'penalty of death' because of our past sins, (since we have all sinned and fall short of the glory of God), (Rom. 3:22). We must understand that Jesus gave His 'life-blood' for us (even before we had repented of our sins), and then we embrace what He has done on the Cross to purchase 'Life' (eternal) for us, .. if we will accept that plan of His for our 'Salvation'. It is something we must choose to believe. Jesus Christ's sacrifice of atonement was an 'eternal sacrifice' which covers everything in a

Christian's life, if <u>we</u> will make <u>that</u> <u>choice</u> to <u>believe</u> it. God promised the <u>gift</u> of His <u>Holy</u> <u>Spirit</u>, and it is for anyone who chooses to sincerely believe on the power of His Son's atonement

Blood sacrifice (that was made in our behalf). (Gal. 3:2) "you received the Spirit because when you heard you believed."

Through the Holy <u>Spirit's</u> guidance, <u>believers</u> will be <u>taught</u> to <u>trust</u> on the <u>power</u> of <u>Jesus'</u> <u>atonement</u> <u>Blood</u> <u>sacrifice</u> for everything in life, and thus, become a <u>child</u> of '<u>God'</u>. (John 1: 12 says) "Yet to all who received him, to those who <u>believed</u> in his Name,.. he gave the <u>right</u> to <u>become</u> children of God."

Mankind was created in the Garden of Eden to be perfectly happy with everything provided pertaining to happiness (no strife, trouble, poverty, pains, aches, or anything else that could spoil their perfect happiness. The story of God's Creation can be encouraging and refreshing to read and understand (by the grace of God) what those conditions of perfect happiness must have been like. It is something we can choose to enjoy, because God created us as free-moral agents who can choose our own path to follow in our life, (God's pathway that leads to Life eternal, or Satan's path that leads to destruction).

The 'free-will choice' that our creator gave us, is the greatest gift that could be given to a created 'being'. God made us <u>independent</u> to <u>choose</u> the path we want to take in everything. This wonderful gift places on us, not only the responsibility of our life, welfare, and

protection here, but full <u>responsibility</u> for our <u>eternal</u> destiny. To be enabled by God to understand this 'power of choice' that we were given (how it was used in a wrong way by Adam to bring all the trouble on the world), (and how this <u>choice can</u> <u>be</u> <u>used</u> to <u>deliver</u> us <u>from</u> that trouble), is a most <u>valuable</u> <u>knowledge</u> indeed! It <u>solves</u> every problem for us.

Satan has most professing Christians) and denominational Churches in the world) <u>blaming God</u> for serious things that happen in their life. <u>Most preachers even place responsibility on God</u> for someone's 'passing',... saying, that it "was God's will to <u>take them</u>". However, the Bible puts <u>all blame on</u> the <u>devil</u>, for causing one to use their 'power of choice' in a <u>wrong</u> way and listening to Satan's lies and alternative plans (instead of relying on <u>the power</u> and <u>benefits</u> of the atonement work of Christ for the fulfillment of God's 'promises').

It is the same concerning our <u>eternal life</u>. We (and every other human being) are <u>responsible</u> for <u>where</u> we spend eternity, and God provided a <u>plan</u> for us to <u>get</u> <u>eternal Life</u>. He doesn't ask us to provide any 'light' or 'power' (of our own), but just a willingness to allow Him to prepare ourselves. He has not only <u>given</u> us eternal Life, but He has taken it <u>upon Himself</u> to <u>prepare</u> us for it, (<u>through</u> the sanctifying work of the Holy Spirit in our heart).

God has made ample provision for us by His Son's atonement sacrifice, and He is the perfect Teacher and master Workman to remove 'self' (which prepares our heart). We are only to <u>surrender</u> our life to God for <u>self</u> to <u>be removed</u> and <u>believe</u> to <u>receive</u> God's abundant <u>mercy</u> in this life (and in Eternity).

If we will choose to place ourselves in His hands (and hold steady in faith), He will perfect us in everything that pertains to this life, and also prepare us for eternal Life. But if we refuse to listen to God, and instead, choose to listen to the devil and <u>follow</u> <u>his</u> plans, nothing can save us from the Lake of Fire (because, in reality we would be <u>rejecting</u> the power of Christ's atonement work accomplished for us). (Matt.10:33) "But whoever disowns me before men I also will disown before my Father who is in Heaven."

It is only by the <u>merciful love</u> of <u>God the</u> <u>Father</u> that His Son's blood was shed on the Cross for us, to pardon, cleanse, and pay for our forgiveness (the <u>price</u> to <u>purchase</u> our <u>'salvation</u>'). That <u>'grace</u>' <u>extended</u> (to all who are found to be <u>trusting in</u> the Son of God 'to the end of the age'), <u>is</u>, the <u>vital</u> part of the 'message of the Cross' that <u>Jesus</u> brought to us.

That is the message He and His disciples taught to <u>everyone else</u> who <u>will</u> <u>`listen'</u> to His teaching, and <u>`follow'</u> <u>Him</u> in real `obedient faith', <u>depending on</u> the <u>power</u> of His shed <u>Blood</u> on the Cross, (which <u>supports</u> every <u>promise</u> given us in Scripture). <u>They</u> are the people whom the Holy Spirit will enlighten to understand His Word, and <u>inspire</u> <u>them</u> to obey and follow it, <u>because</u> the Holy Spirit is for 'believers'..not for unbelievers.

Jesus explained that the Holy Spirit would be sent to the <u>obedient</u> in the <u>faith</u> (meaning 'believers', who will <u>grow</u> through the Spirit), (John 14:15-16) "If you love me, you will <u>obey</u> my commandments. <u>And I will ask the Father</u>, and He will give you another Advocate to be forever with you-- the 'Spirit' of truth."

However, that Spirit was not sent for <u>unbelievers</u>, as Jesus explained (vs.17), "That Spirit, the 'world' (unbelievers) <u>cannot</u> receive, because it <u>does not see Him</u> or <u>know Him</u>. You know Him because He <u>remains</u> by your side and <u>is in you</u>."

Jesus had <u>already</u> given the <u>instructions</u> (John 14:1), "Trust in <u>God: trust in Me also." Now He is assuring</u> all 'believers' <u>of</u> His Father's <u>blessing</u> of the Holy Spirit, "Who" would help them <u>learn</u> to '<u>trust' in Him</u>, (and God, His Father)." The human heart always wants to trust in some <u>seen</u> thing, rather than the <u>Word</u> and 'Promises' of the <u>unseen</u> God.

Many people have sought (and received) advice from the Scriptures, but they <u>refused</u> to <u>accept</u> it, and went their own way. They eventually came to grief because they used their power of choice to follow the <u>devil's</u> way (instead of choosing God's way of depending on the power of Jesus' atonement <u>Blood</u> <u>sacrifice</u> and <u>the</u> <u>benefits</u> that it provided for everyone to <u>claim</u> and <u>receive</u> by <u>faith</u>. They were wholly <u>responsible</u> for any sad results (due to their wrong choices), instead of them relying on the power of Jesus' Blood.

For <u>anyone</u> who <u>will</u> give <u>God</u> the <u>opportunity</u>, He will bring them to His plan and the <u>fulfillment</u> of His <u>Promises</u> confirmed by His Son's atonement work (2 Cor. 1:20) "For all <u>the promises</u> of God, (whatever their number), have their <u>confirmation</u> in Him; and <u>for this reason</u> through Him also, <u>our</u> "Amen" <u>acknowledges</u> their <u>truth</u> and <u>promotes</u> the glory of God through <u>our</u> faith."

<u>God</u> will make each one <u>victorious</u> through His provisional plan for all who will <u>trust</u> on Him. It will not only make <u>them</u> <u>victorious</u>, but it will <u>reach</u> to <u>their family</u>. The righteousness of a wife will reach to her <u>husband</u>, or a husband's righteousness to his <u>wife</u>. It will reach their <u>children</u> (and even grandchildren) if the grandparents live within God's plan to be <u>fully trusting</u> on what the atonement Blood of Christ <u>provided</u>. (Psalm 103:17-18) "But the mercy of the Lord is from everlasting to everlasting On those who fear Him, And His righteousness to <u>children's children</u>, <u>To such</u> as <u>keep His</u> <u>covenant</u>, And to <u>those</u> who <u>remember</u> His <u>commandments</u> to <u>do</u> them."

Just as <u>importantly</u>, we must <u>realize</u> that as <u>we repent</u> and give up <u>efforts</u> of the <u>self-life</u> (and things we have gotten via the selflife), it is <u>God</u> who will then <u>enable</u> us to also <u>`come to Him</u>' with a truly repentant heart, and to <u>`remember His commandments</u> to do them."

Jesus <u>set</u> an <u>example</u> for living a <u>sinless</u> life' (even though He was tempted just as we are all tempted"). By living a life of <u>faith</u> and trust' in His Father, <u>He</u> set an <u>example</u> by which we also (in faith and trust) <u>are to follow Him</u>. (Heb.12:2-4) "Let us <u>fix</u> our <u>eyes</u> on <u>Jesus</u>, the <u>author</u> and <u>perfecter</u> of our <u>faith</u>, who for the joy set before him endured the cross, scorning its shame, and sat down at the right hand of the throne of God. <u>Consider him</u> who endured such opposition from sinful men, so that you will <u>not grow weary</u> and <u>lose</u> <u>heart</u>. In your <u>struggle</u> <u>against</u> <u>sin</u>, you have not yet resisted to the point of shedding your blood."

The plan given in God's <u>`Salvation Message'</u> covers every-thing in a Christian's life, <u>including</u> our <u>spiritual</u> development and <u>growth</u> ("`<u>growth in holiness'</u> apart from which no one will see the Lord." (Heb.12:14). "Persistently strive for that growth."

God's plan (founded on the power of the Atonement) <u>delivers</u> us <u>from</u> sin and Satan's power, and provides <u>for</u> the healing of our body, the peace in our home, personal peace within ourselves, and for everything else that concerns us. His plan is simplicity in itself. All it is, is for us to learn under God's teaching, (and the strength and guidance that <u>He</u> provides), to get us rid of all the things we <u>have been trusting in</u> for the health of our bodies, for our home life, our financial affairs, and for our friends and <u>everything else</u>. God wants us to <u>come to Him</u> (to trust in Him) <u>like</u> little children. Jesus said (Matt.18:3), "I tell you the truth, <u>unless</u> you <u>change</u> and become <u>like</u> little children, you will never enter the Kingdom of Heaven." We are to simply turn to God's plan of trusting on Him (instead of turning away and trusting on plans of 'self' or someone else). God's plan is very easy to follow.

We should <u>learn</u> to <u>trust</u> <u>God</u> to find Christian <u>friends</u> for us, and then to control their attitude toward us (and ours toward them). Any person who has <u>heard</u> <u>God's</u> <u>Truth</u> (and will trust God in this way instead of using human efforts), will enjoy happiness in their home. Anyone who will take a <u>Scriptural</u> <u>stand</u> to <u>trust</u> <u>on</u> <u>God</u> to provide a lifetime companion, He will bring a perfect mate for them. <u>Trusting</u> <u>God</u> in this very important matter is the only <u>safe</u> <u>way</u>. For those who were married before they came to know the Truth, <u>God</u> can take the worst husband (or wife) and <u>change</u> their attitude, so they will not do anything to disturb the other's peace (with human efforts <u>put</u> <u>aside</u> and God alone <u>trusted on</u> to restore peace).

Jesus Christ's work on the Cross at Calvary <u>restored</u> every-thing that Adam's sin <u>took</u> from us. It is <u>already</u> <u>ours</u> through the Blood of Christ (as much as it <u>was</u> Adam's in the Garden of Eden <u>before</u> he disobeyed God. We are to get it back by <u>reversing</u> the plan that the <u>devil</u> used to <u>mislead</u> <u>Adam</u>, as we believe <u>God's</u> <u>Word</u> (and reject the devil's <u>lies</u>). Adam's mistake (a <u>serious</u> one) was to believe the devil and doubt God's Word.

There is no other way to have perfect conditions of the Garden of Eden restored in our life, than to accept and believe the Word of God, which is the Truth founded on <u>fact</u>. If Adam could believe the <u>lies</u> of the devil, surely, by God's grace, anyone should believe the <u>Word</u> of a <u>truthful God</u> (who is always present to give us the <u>spiritual grace</u> to <u>believe</u> and <u>receive</u> our victory). Jesus said (Rev.3:18) "Therefore I <u>counsel</u> you to buy of <u>Me</u>, gold <u>refined</u> in the fire that you may become rich, and <u>white</u> robes to put on", (that means deliverance from sin and the devil, and be clothed with God's righteousness), "so as to hide your shameful nakedness, and eye-salve to anoint your eyes with, so that you may be able to see." (That means to enable <u>believers</u> to see in <u>faith</u> "the things that are so <u>freely given us</u> of God") (1 Cor. 2:12), (meaning, that Jesus Christ's work on the Cross at Calvary, restored everything that Adam took from us.

(2 Cor.4:3-4 <u>reminds</u> true believers) "And even if our gospel is veiled, it is veiled to <u>those who are perishing</u>. The god of this age has <u>blinded the minds</u> of <u>unbelievers</u>, so that they <u>cannot see the</u> <u>`light of the gospel'</u> of the glory of Christ, who <u>is the image of</u> <u>God</u>." (We must <u>believe</u> God's <u>Word</u> that Jesus Christ's atonement work not only cleansed us from sin, but that it also restored everything that Adam's sin took away from us.)

Any one of these parts of the <u>Atonement</u> that we have been considering, would bring perfect <u>victory</u>, fulness of <u>blessing</u> and <u>deliverance</u>. First, that Christ already <u>bore</u> for <u>us</u>, the burden of every sin, sorrow, disease, home problem, and everything else. (Isaiah 53:4-5 Moffatt's) "And yet ours was the pain He bore, the sorrow He endured! We thought Him suffering from a stroke at God's hand; yet He was wounded because we had sinned, twas our misdeeds that crushed Him; twas for <u>our welfare</u> that He was chastised, the <u>blows</u> that <u>fell</u> to <u>Him</u> have brought us HEALING."

Secondly, the aspect of having everything paid for by the Blood of Christ and "freely given us of God", would <u>include</u> God, Himself, Jesus Christ, the Holy Spirit, (and everything else that we could need for our <u>spiritual</u> life), (home life, peace within and without, ...our health, and financial needs and supplies).

A <u>third</u> (and a <u>most important</u>) aspect is, the <u>change</u> of heart that the Atonement work of Christ made in us, as we <u>believe</u> that it <u>did</u> an effective work to <u>change</u> our entire life. To truly believe that Jesus Christ changed our character and nature <u>by</u> His atonement sacrifice, is the most <u>direct</u> and the <u>only positive</u> way of having Christ to live within our heart and have us <u>receive</u> the <u>benefits</u> of His great Atonement.

When Adam believed the <u>devil</u> and <u>doubted</u> <u>God</u>, his character changed to be <u>opposite</u> to what it was, and opposite to what God had intended. By Adam using his 'power of choice' in a wrong way, he became controlled by Satan (and lost all knowledge of God).

Adam's Son, Abel, made an offering of a <u>slain lamb</u>, (a poor <u>type</u> of Jesus Christ' blood sacrifice). Abel had <u>no merit</u> of himself to appease God, "But Abel brought fat portions from some of the firstborn of his flock. The LORD looked with <u>favor</u> on Abel and his offering," (says, Gen. 4:4). Abel's <u>character</u> (attitude) was <u>changed</u>. Instead of having the evil nature and being under the control of Satan, he had the righteousness of God <u>restored</u> in him (which his father and mother had in the Garden of Eden, <u>before</u> Eve was <u>deceived</u> by Satan and fell to sin).

Jesus Christ (through His great work on the Cross) <u>restored</u> the nature of God <u>for</u> <u>us</u>. We must <u>believe</u> that <u>He made</u> <u>us</u> Christ-like, gave us the image of God, and took from us the guilt and power of sin and Satan. Everyone has that privilege of taking the attitude of seeing ourselves <u>restored</u> (as God's Word says), regardless of anything in us, or what we have done or could do, because there is <u>no merit</u> in us, and no merit in anything that we could do!! It is all because of what <u>Jesus Christ</u> <u>did</u> for <u>us</u>. (Isaiah 53:5) "twas for <u>our</u> welfare that <u>He</u> was chastised, the <u>blows</u> that <u>fell</u> to <u>Him</u> have <u>brought</u> <u>us</u> <u>HEALING</u>." (That includes <u>spiritual</u> and physical 'healing' and 'blessing' more-so than anything else because God's blessing of a spiritual nature can only come from a 'life of faith' on the work accomplished on the Cross) (as we see ourselves (in faith) <u>at</u> the feet of Jesus Christ).

The Bible clearly tells us <u>how</u> we are to see ourselves <u>when we</u> <u>believe</u> on the <u>atonement sacrifice</u> that Jesus Christ made for us. (Gal. 2:20), "I have been crucified with Christ, and it is no longer I that live, but Christ that lives in me; and the life which I <u>now live</u> in the body I live <u>through faith</u> in the Son of God who <u>loved me</u> and <u>gave Himself</u> up to <u>death</u> on my behalf."

The atoning 'Blood sacrifice' of Jesus Christ, changes our <u>spiritual nature</u> and character and attitude,... <u>if we base our hope</u> on <u>that alone</u>; ... because everything in the true Christian life is 'covered by the Atonement'!!

2... Equally important is why Jesus had to make that sacrifice, what He accomplished for us by doing so, and the benefits that can be received by anyone who will make the free-will 'choice' to believe on the power of Christ's 'Atonement Blood'.
