GOD'S PLAN PROVIDES OUR DELIVERANCE

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People in Bible times who learned about God's plan of trust received a deliverance that His plan has provided for them. There-fore, <u>we</u> should realize how important and valuable it is to find out for ourselves what God's plan is all about. Satan has always tried to conceal God's plan or confuse it with many worldly plans that he has devised to <u>rob</u> people of <u>receiving</u> the <u>benefits</u> of what <u>God provided</u> for us <u>and</u> keep them <u>from finding out</u> what God is really like.

The truth is that God's plan is plain and easy to follow, and His many promises are <u>found</u> in His <u>Word</u>, and each one is backed by the almighty power of the sacrificial blood that His Son shed for us on Calvary's Cross. God's plan actually began in the Garden of Eden, where God created man to be happy and contented and with every needed thing provided for him. Man was also to be <u>protected</u> in that happiness, have a mind filled with God's peace, God's righteousness, and <u>His blessing</u> <u>of perfect health</u>. Hard labor and difficult upsetting working conditions were not part of God's plan. Instead, everything was provided for <u>man to be</u> perfectly <u>happy</u>, and he <u>was</u> perfectly happy.

God <u>also</u> gave humans a power of choice, and they <u>could have remained</u> in that happy state <u>if</u> Adam and Eve <u>had used that</u> 'power of choice' correctly. It was a greatest of gifts a Creator could have given to created beings (but the choice would have to be used right).

But Satan appeared and deceived the first people with what he made to <u>look</u> <u>like</u> a wonderful offer, saying, that if they would listen to him they would become their own gods, knowing as much as God knew, and being able to do as much as God did. <u>That is Satan's scheme for deceiving the whole world</u>, and to get everyone <u>away</u> <u>from</u> God's <u>Word</u>, (by having them refuse to listen to <u>God</u>, and instead, to listen to him). <u>Listening to Satan's lies is the cause of all troubles</u>.

We are naturally susceptible to seeing things the way the devil says they are. Everyone born since Adam was born under the devil's control and grew up under it, so a person will get as used to it as breathing (but <u>without knowing it</u>). However, when we turn our back on the <u>lie</u> that we <u>thought</u> was true, and we <u>choose</u> to follow an entirely different (but <u>true) teaching</u> (which may <u>seem</u> mysterious or perplexing <u>at</u> <u>first</u>), we will soon find that it really is simplicity in itself. And there is a <u>plan</u> in God's Word to use in every situation of life (in dealing with our fellowman).

Adam and Eve used their power of choice to <u>turn from</u> the security of God's plan to the <u>in</u>security of Satan's plans of the <u>self-life</u>; (and the results were <u>terrible</u>). <u>Mankind</u> became a <u>different being</u> because they <u>changed from</u> the nature of <u>God to</u> the <u>devil's nature</u> (but without realizing it). It is important for us that that is understood because when their attitude to God changed (to directly <u>opposite to</u> what it <u>had been</u>), <u>that is when trouble began</u>. They had come under the control of Satan, and everyone born from that day to this has been born under that <u>same control</u> of <u>self</u>.

The devil's control has one basic characteristic, which is to depend completely

S268R GOD'S PLAN PROVIDES OUR DELIVERANCE 7 20 2022 2. on <u>ourselves</u> (or some <u>other person</u>), or a plan inspired by the devil and devised by man, to get what we want in this life. It <u>is</u> trying by our own efforts to get back to the perfect happiness that God had given to man in the Garden of Eden.

We were created with an <u>instinct</u> to be happy, and <u>that is</u> the <u>incentive</u> for everything a person does in their life. Every word spoken, and every <u>step taken</u> by <u>humans</u> has <u>one object</u>, that is, to find the happiness that was enjoyed in the Garden of Eden but to get it by their <u>own efforts</u>. We can easily see that the more people try by human efforts, the farther they get away from their objective (and the further away from <u>God's plan for receiving things through</u> a life of trust) (with good <u>spiritual</u> results).

<u>Human efforts</u> are the <u>foundation</u> of <u>Satan</u>'s <u>control</u>. Every <u>evil thing</u> in <u>the</u> <u>world</u> overall and in <u>individual lives</u> has <u>one foundation cause</u> (or origin), that is, a human effort <u>apart from</u> God and His power, to <u>obtain what one desires</u> in this life.

When Adam and Eve <u>rebelled against God</u>, it <u>meant</u> that they were sentenced to death (and everyone else <u>was born in</u> that <u>same</u> terrible <u>spiritual condition</u>). It is much the same in human affairs, for we can see how zealous a country is to find persons who are disloyal to the Government. When a spy is captured, they are prosecuted to the fullest extent of the law, because <u>treason</u> (in the Bible or out of it) was always punishable by death. The only way the human race could <u>atone</u> for their <u>rebellion against God</u> would be to die for it. God knew (as we know) that it would not be proper to execute someone for treason that another person was responsible for. Adam is the one who was truly <u>guilty</u>, but we <u>were born under that curse</u> for <u>treason thru</u> that sin of Adam (so just as <u>punishable</u> by death as was Adam's sin).

Instead of <u>everyone</u> having to die because of <u>the disloyal act</u> of <u>another person</u>, <u>God</u> (in His great mercy and love), <u>sent</u> His only Son, Jesus Christ, to die <u>in our</u> <u>place</u>. Christ <u>is divine</u>, and He <u>has</u> the <u>same nature as</u> <u>God</u>. Everything was created <u>by</u> Him and <u>for</u> Him, and He <u>was before</u> all things. Jesus <u>is</u> the most valuable part of God's universe, and the most valuable <u>One</u> in it. God in His great mercy for us sent Jesus to this earth to die <u>for us!!</u>

It is a <u>most important</u> fact for each one of us to understand, that <u>when Jesus</u> <u>Christ died</u> for us, it was exactly <u>the same as if we had died</u> (for our own sins and rebellion against God). He actually <u>paid the penalty for us</u>, and it was the <u>necessary</u> and only requirement that <u>had</u> to be paid to <u>atone</u> for sin. It was an eternal sacrifice <u>for</u> sins, past and present, and any sins that are confessed to God in the future. His work on the Cross provided everything needed to atone <u>for our</u> sins, for <u>where</u> sin <u>hath abounded</u> (which it certainly <u>has</u>), <u>mercy did much more abound</u>. [God's mercy was extended to each one of us, and it is <u>His plan</u> for our deliverance from <u>sin and</u> every attack from the devil if we will only <u>accept</u> His <u>offer</u> and <u>believe</u> on Him <u>in faith</u> <u>to receive it</u>. <u>Everything</u> in the <u>true Christian life</u> is received <u>by faith</u>, even to our believing that we have been pardoned <u>through</u> the blood of Christ, cleansed, <u>and</u> forgiven <u>by</u> His blood, and made <u>worthy by</u> His blood to receive Eternal Life.]

God's provision for us was far more than we could ever need or use. He

S268R GOD'S PLAN PROVIDES OUR DELIVERANCE 7 20 2022 3. pardoned our sins, and He will continue to pardon us when we <u>come to Him</u> in <u>sincere repentance</u>. He cleansed <u>our hearts</u> and has more cleansing for us than we could ever need. His <u>righteousness</u> (to <u>be extended</u> to the true <u>believer</u>), is greater than any sin we ever committed. (Romans 5:17), "For <u>if by</u> the one man's offense <u>death reigned through</u> the one, <u>much more, those</u> who receive <u>abundance of grace</u> and <u>of the gift of righteousness</u>, will reign in <u>life</u> through <u>the One</u>, Jesus Christ."

So, we can see from Scripture, that <u>the provision</u> is far <u>greater than the need</u>. Greater <u>health</u> than we could ever need is <u>in</u> the Atonement of Christ. More <u>peace</u> in our life, or more money than we could ever use <u>is also provided in</u> the <u>Atonement</u> <u>work of Christ</u>. If we can be enabled to see it <u>as plain</u> and <u>simple as</u> it <u>is</u>, that when Christ died for us, it was exactly <u>the same</u> as <u>if we</u> had been executed for our sin of rebellion against God. It is of great importance for us to <u>understand</u>, that His death made us as free from sin, sorrow, disease, and poverty <u>as if we had died</u> and were absolutely free from it all). (We only have to admit to our sins and confess them and see ourselves forgiven <u>because</u> the <u>price of atonement</u> has been paid... <u>Jesus</u> paid it all (<u>for us</u>). We only have to <u>believe</u> in real faith that we <u>are free</u> from sorrow, illness, or poverty to be delivered from it (because <u>of</u> the shed blood of Christ).

Anyone in the Bible who understood that and believed it was delivered from the trouble they were in. So, we need to put great emphasis on and understand that thoroughly. It isn't anything that we could do (or have done), that will deliver us from our sins, sorrow, illness, or poverty. <u>Rather, it is because</u> of what Christ has already done on the Cross for us <u>if</u> we would <u>only accept that fact</u> and <u>place our trust</u> on Him (as God told us we have to do to receive the benefits of His Atonement work). <u>That is the only condition</u> (or <u>requirement</u>) that God <u>puts on His eternal plan for</u> our <u>deliverance</u>, (that is, to <u>be</u> a '<u>believer</u>' on Him whom He has sent, His Son Jesus.)

Members of most churches in the world are trying to find peace and happiness (or get back to the conditions that God created in the Garden of Eden) via their own self-efforts. Their <u>efforts of self</u> (and trusting in man's plans to get the things they want to be happy in this life), takes them further <u>away from</u> what Christ has already accomplished for them on the Cross. Most are not trusting on the Son of God <u>for</u> <u>anything in their life</u>. It is the sin of <u>unbelief</u> (or idolatry), which is the worst sin of all (the Apostle Paul explained).

It is not a matter of what we do by self-efforts to be <u>free from bondage of Satan</u>, it is what someone else, Jesus Christ, <u>has already done</u> for us. <u>That is what sets people</u> <u>free</u>, it is what <u>delivers them</u>, and what brings answer to prayer, <u>and</u> that is what <u>gives the victory</u>, (as well as rich spiritual <u>growth</u> and development in the Truth).

The late Pastor said that someone told him they had a difficult battle to meet, and they just told God, "I am going to place my <u>whole claim</u> and <u>hope of victory on</u> the <u>blood</u> of <u>Jesus Christ</u> and His <u>great work</u> on the Cross". <u>They got</u> a full deliverance at once, and that is the way it always was in the Bible. In the Old Testament, <u>faith in</u> even the <u>poorest type of Jesus Christ</u> (a serpent hung on a tree or a slain animal), brought perfect victory spiritually, physically, financially, and in S268R GOD'S PLAN PROVIDES OUR DELIVERANCE 7 20 2022 everything else.

So, when Jesus Christ died on the Cross, it was <u>our</u> death, and we were scripturally and justly <u>set free</u> from sin, sorrow, and illness. (Most importantly), we are <u>delivered from the influence</u> of <u>the devil</u> and the <u>control</u> of <u>the evil nature</u>, <u>if</u> we <u>truly believe that</u> we <u>are delivered from</u> it and believe that the <u>Holy Spirit</u> will <u>control</u> us <u>as we allow Him</u> to <u>do so</u>.

Most people have never fully realized that the perfect work of Jesus Christ on the Cross <u>delivered us from</u> sin, from its <u>guilt</u>, its <u>power</u>, and, from the devil and his power and influence. Also, delivered from sickness, illness, infirmities, and oppressions of the body, as well as from <u>poverty</u> and <u>every other disturbance of</u> our <u>peace</u>, and from the other evil things around us in this life. Because of the work of Christ on the Cross, we have every Atonement right to be <u>delivered from</u> wrong desires <u>as we resist the devil</u> steadfast in <u>faith</u> and on the <u>power</u> of <u>Jesus' blood</u> to deliver us.

When Jesus Christ died, it made us free from all the evil things that we inherited from the first <u>Adam</u>. The Atonement <u>made us as</u> he was <u>when</u> he was first created (before he used his <u>power of choice in the wrong way</u> and <u>fell away from</u> God's <u>grace</u>). Our freedom from sin was paid for by the blood of Christ. It was nothing in us or nothing that we <u>have done</u> or <u>could do</u>, but altogether <u>what</u> Jesus Christ <u>did for us</u>. [The Bible doesn't say that the work of Atonement puts everybody in Heaven. It says that the Atonement work delivers us from sin (especially from the sin of the 'self-life'), if we will believe that and accept it, and begin trusting on the Son of God (instead of <u>self</u> and sins of a <u>self-life</u>. <u>That</u> is <u>God's</u> '<u>Message of Salvation'.</u>]

<u>That is the Truth that sets people free</u>. That is what the Bible teaches, and God has made it as plain as possible <u>for us to grasp</u> and to <u>receive</u> the great <u>benefits</u> from <u>knowing</u> and <u>believing</u> it. It is the <u>Truth</u> that <u>sets people free</u>!!

When Jesus Christ was raised from the dead, it was exactly the same as if we had come back to life as an entirely different (and new) person. We need to <u>believe</u> that <u>is what</u> He has already done for us and consecrate ourselves to living a life of <u>faith</u> on what the power of <u>His shed blood</u> has <u>accomplished</u> (to <u>pardon</u>, <u>cleanse</u>, and <u>pay for our forgiveness</u>). When He was raised to life, death was conquered, and we were raised to life with Him, if we will only believe on Him whom God has sent. That is <u>God's plan</u> for our <u>deliverance</u> and Salvation.

In God's sight, Jesus Christ tasted <u>death</u> for <u>every</u> human being, and <u>that</u> is what <u>delivers us</u> from <u>that sin of rebellion we inherited</u> from Adam as well as from all disturbances of our peace (including sorrow and sickness). (The shed blood of Jesus Christ covers <u>everything</u> in the life of the true believer (who will place themselves and loved ones, and all that <u>God</u> has provided for them <u>under His protective blood</u>). That is what it really means to <u>be in union with Jesus Christ</u>.

We were <u>counted as</u> dead when He died and counted <u>as alive spiritually when</u> He <u>was raised from the grave</u>. That new <u>life</u> 'in <u>union with</u> Christ', is for everyone S268R GOD'S PLAN PROVIDES OUR DELIVERANCE 7 20 2022 5. born since Adam fell into sin. The perfect sacrifice of God's only Son (the perfect Son of God) to deliver us, cannot be improved upon. Therefore, it was an <u>eternal</u> sacrifice made in our behalf, which could not have been accomplished by any other person or by any type of animal sacrifice (for <u>all others</u> would <u>be imperfect</u>). That is why the perfect <u>Son</u> of God, had to be sent to earth <u>by the mercy</u> of <u>God</u> (His Heavenly Father), to take the curse of Adam's rebellion away from us by His <u>taking</u> <u>our place</u> by dying <u>for us</u> on the Cross. <u>Why</u> Jesus Christ died on the Cross <u>is</u> <u>something we all must understand</u> (accept and <u>place</u> our <u>faith on</u>). That <u>is why</u> we partake of the bread and juice of the vine, in remembrance of His broken body and His blood shed <u>for us</u> on the Cross at Calvary.

God tells us just <u>how</u> we are <u>to connect up with</u> our <u>inheritance</u> that He <u>provided</u> in <u>His</u> plan to <u>deliver</u> us <u>from sin</u> and <u>Satan</u>'s <u>bondage</u> (by sending His Son to die for <u>our</u> sins). God inspired the Apostle Paul (5th. chapter of Romans) to say(vs.1) "Standing then acquitted as the <u>result</u> of <u>faith</u>, let us <u>enjoy peace</u> with God through our Lord Jesus Christ, through <u>whom also</u>, as <u>the result of faith</u>, we have <u>obtained</u> an <u>introduction</u> into that <u>state</u> of <u>favor</u> with God in which we stand, and we <u>exult in hope</u> of <u>some day sharing</u> in God's glory."

(In chapter 6:1-4, Paul said), "What shall we say then? Shall we <u>continue</u> in sin, that <u>grace</u> may abound?" (Paul was saying, shall we continue to live in ways of the <u>old life</u>, that God's mercy and grace may be greater, and bring more glory to Him for being more merciful to us?) Then Paul used the strongest language known to man, "<u>God forbid</u>". Then (vs 2-4) "How shall we, that are <u>dead</u> to sin, live any longer therein? Know ye not, that so many of us as were baptized into Jesus Christ were baptized into his death? Therefore, we are buried <u>with him</u> by <u>baptism</u> into <u>death</u>: that <u>like as</u> Christ was <u>raised up from</u> the <u>dead by</u> the <u>glory</u> of the <u>Father</u>, even so <u>we</u> <u>also</u> should <u>walk</u> in <u>newness</u> of <u>life</u>." (Fully delivered from <u>sin</u> and Satan and <u>self</u>). It is <u>the same</u> in regard to disease, trouble, and poverty, which were also taken away by Christ's work on the Cross. More <u>health</u> and prosperity than we could ever need is <u>in</u> the Atonement work of Christ.

When a person has died, they are freed from sin. We would not make an accusation against a person who had passed away. Well, we have to <u>see ourselves as</u> having <u>died with Christ</u> (just as much as if we had gone into the grave with Him), and we had that evil nature taken away and <u>destroyed</u>, then we <u>can see ourselves</u> as walking in <u>newness of life</u>, free from Satan's <u>attacks and his influence</u> over our life.

We are <u>delivered from that curse of Adam's rebellion against God</u> and made free by the <u>second</u> Adam, Jesus Christ. "How shall we that are dead to sin, live any longer therein?" (The Bible says), <u>so that is</u> the <u>way</u> we have to <u>believe</u> that we <u>are</u> because of the <u>mercy of God</u>

in sending His Son, Jesus Christ to die for us. (Gal.3:22 <u>reminds us</u>), "But <u>Scripture</u> <u>has shown that</u> all mankind are the prisoners of sin, <u>in order that</u> the <u>promised</u> <u>blessing</u>, which <u>depends on faith</u> in <u>Jesus Christ</u>, may be given to <u>those</u> who <u>believe</u>."

That is God's plan and His provision for our deliverance to believe on the One

s268R GOD'S PLAN PROVIDES OUR DELIVERANCE 7 20 2022 6. whom <u>He has sent to the Cross</u> to die in our stead <u>and</u> to place our <u>trust</u> on Him that we may be <u>saved from</u> condemnation along with the world. "<u>He who trusts on Him</u> does <u>not come</u> up for judgement." (We are told, John 3:18).

We <u>are delivered</u> by the <u>Atonement work of Christ</u>. [<u>Delivered from</u> the curse of a life of <u>self</u> and mercifully brought to a life of trust on <u>the</u> Son of God. It was all paid for in that atoning work of Jesus Christ on a cross on our behalf to deliver us.]

1. The work of atonement that God sent His Son to do on Calvary's Cross was His plan to deliver us from the curse of Adam's sin.

2. Adam's sin of rebellion was <u>treason</u> against God, a crime that is always punishable by death.

3. The price for sin had to be paid for with sacrificial blood, for as Scripture says, "without the shedding of blood, there is no remission of sin."

4. The perfect Son of God was the only One who could pay that price, for <u>no other</u> being on earth was unblemished and <u>could</u> pay that price for mankind. &&&&&&
